



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


Lifespan of a health professional

Brazil's NHS




✓ There is no other way but to strengthen an effective PHC system, which can address and solve 80% of health care demand.

✓ Currently, there are 48,000 Family Health
Teams spread all around the country covering
<65% population.

✓ They cover geographic/population districts and are hired locally by municipalities.

Open access to health knowledge.


Learning is a lifelong process, aiming at problem solving.








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Ranging from soft to strict certifications, online to offline, profession-centered to widely offered and more:

- Self-learning certified Modules: Dengue, Influenza, Chikungunya, Malaria.
- Equity issues: LGBT, Indigenous, Afro-descendants and others.
- ✓ Total enrolments near 200,000 health professionals.

Accessibility and spreading potential of IT/CE is much bigger than face-to-face education.




It can work either online or offline, for those places without broadband internet.



It works centered at the student's needs, at his own pace and must be friendly (games, cases and so on).








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- ✓ Well educated, motivated and managed health workers are the core of any health system.
